

CANDLE SAFETY

Candles can provide a warm and festive atmosphere – but they can also be a fire hazard if left unattended or placed near anything flammable. The Jackson Fire Department encourages families to enjoy the warm and inviting atmosphere of candles while always keeping fire safety in mind:

- **Never leave candles unattended.**
 - **Extinguish all candles before going to sleep or leaving the room.**
 - **Keep candles at least three feet away from anything that can burn.**
 - **Always use stable, nonflammable candleholders.**
- **Place candles where they will be out of reach of pets and young children,**
- **Do not permit children to keep or use candles or incense in their rooms.**
- **Candles should only be used when a sober adult is present and awake.**
