

CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS

THE HOME SAFETY COUNCIL RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES TO PROTECT YOUR FAMILY FROM CO POISONING:

*INSTALL AT LEAST 1 UNDERWRITERS LABORATORIES (UL) LISTED CO ALARM IN YOUR HOME; NEAR SLEEPING AREAS.

*SHOULD YOUR CO ALARM ALERT YOU TO AN INCREASE IN CO, EVACUATE YOUR HOME AND CALL 911.

*TEST YOUR CO ALARM MONTHLY.

*CO ALARMS ARE NOT SUBSTITUTES FOR SMOKE ALARMS. EVERY HOME SHOULD HAVE SMOKE ALARMS ON EACH LEVEL.

*HAVE A TRAINED PROFESSIONAL INSPECT, CLEAN AND TUNE-UP THE CENTRAL HEATING SYSTEM EACH YEAR.

- INSTALL CO ALARMS IN EACH SLEEPING ARE.
- IF YOU ALREADY HAVE CO ALARMS, TEST THEM MONTHLY.
