

DRIVER SAFETY

WHEN AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE WITH LIGHTS AND SIREN IS MOVING ALONG A STREET, DRIVERS SHOULD BE PULLING OVER TO THE RIGHT AND STOPPING UNTIL THE VEHICLE HAS PASSED.

THE SECONDS LOST MOVING AROUND A VEHICLE THAT DOES NOT STOP OR STOPPING FOR A VEHICLE THAT TURNS IN FRONT OF AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE COULD BE THE DIFFERENCE IN SOMEONES LIFE OR AMOUNT OF PROPERTY DAMAGE.

SCHOOLS WILL BE OPENING SOON AND YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF INCREASE IN CHILDREN ALONG STREETS COMING AND GOING FROM SCHOOL. ALSO DRIVERS SHOULD BE AWARE OF SCHOOL BUSES. REMEMBER YOU MUST STOP FOR A BUS THAT IS LOADING AND UNLOADING. IF THE BUS IS ON A DIVIDED HIGHWAY, THE ONCOMING TRAFFIC DOES NOT HAVE TO STOP, ONLY THE TRAFFIC BEHIND THE BUS.

AT ACCIDENT SCENES, DRIVERS SHOULD SLOW DOWN AND MOVE TO THE LEFT ON DIVIDE HIGHWAYS. ON TWO LANE ROADS BE PREPARED TO STOP AND LOOK FOR PERSONNEL DIRECTING TRAFFIC. ROADWAYS ARE ALWAYS OPEN BACK UP AS SOON AS IT IS SAFE TO DO SO, PLEASE BE PATIENT.
