ORDINANCE NO. 39-23

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 49-22 THAT PREVIOUSLY VACATED A PORTION OF WEST CIRCLE DRIVE.

WHEREFORE, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson had, by ORD 49-22, and at the request of the petitioners and all the adjacent landowners, vacated a portion of Circle Drive within the City of Jackson; and

WHEREFORE, the petitioners or any adjacent landowners did not accept ownership of the property upon it being vacated and did not cause Ord. 49-12 to be recorded in the Office of the Jackson County Recorder and have requested that Ord. 49-12 be repealed, in furtherance of this request to repeal, the petitioners shall execute a quit claim deed releasing any possible claim to the property to the City of Jackson; and

WHEREFORE, the adjacent landowners and petitioners have requested the City to repeal ORD 49-22; and

Section 1. THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, that ORD. 49-22 IS HEREBY REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRETY.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
