ORDINANCE NO. 50-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE AND SAFETY DIRECTOR TO EXCHANGE AN ATV USED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR A NEW ATV BETTER SUITED FOR USE BY THE CITY, PURSUANT TO R.C. SECTION 721.15 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson, received an ATV as a donation from the Jackson Fire Fighters Association for the intended purpose of fighting brush fires and other uses; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson now finds that the ATV is unfit for that public use and the Jackson Firefighters Association shall purchase a new ATV better suited for this intended purpose and will exchange the new ATV for the current ATV without additional cost and that this exchange is pursuant to R.C. 721.15(B); and

WHEREAS, the City finds that this matter constitutes an emergency necessary to protect the health, safety or welfare of the City so as to allow the immediate purchase of an ATV to be donated to the Jackson Fire Department by the Jackson Firefighters Association in exchange for the current ATV without delay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, THAT THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO EXCHANGE THE EXISTING ATV WITH THE JACKSON FIREFIGHTERS ASSOCIATION FOR AN ATV BETTER SUITED FOR THE JACKSON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and that these deliberations of this council and its committees resulted in such formal action, or in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
