ORDINANCE NO. 16-23

AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY ADOPTING CURRENT REPLACEMENT PAGES THERETO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current State law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Walter H. Drane Company has prepared a supplement containing such amendments; now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO; as follows:

Section One. That, in accordance with Ohio R.C. 731.23, the ordinances of the City of Jackson, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the January 2023 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

<u>Section Two.</u> That the following sections and chapters are hereby added, amended or repealed as respectively indicated in order to comply with current State law:

Traffic Code

General Offenses Code

None at this time

Section Three. That the complete text of the sections of the Codified Ordinances listed above are set forth in full in the current replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A. Any summary publication of this ordinance shall include a complete listing of these sections. Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

Section Four. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and for the further reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the current replacement pages to the officials and residents of the City, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.

Section Five. In the event that the Ordinance receives majority vote for passage, but

fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
