ORDINANCE NO. 152-06

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OAPSE TO MODIFY THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson is currently under the terms of a collective bargaining agreement between OAPSE and the City of Jackson, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the City and OAPSE desire to modify the agreement so as to include the position of Director of Water and Wastewater, at a base rate as already established, plus an additional \$5.00 per hour which shall take effect immediately; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the person filling the position of Director of Water and Wastewater shall obtain a class IV license, and when that is accomplished, the person filling the position shall receive an additional \$5.00 per hour on the base pay for the position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The Jackson City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, or his designated representative, to enter into an agreement with OAPSE to amend the collective bargaining agreement so as to include the position of Director of Water and Wastewater at a base rate of pay as already established plus an additional \$5.00 per hour to take effect immediately. In addition, when the person filling the position obtains a class IV operator's license, the person's base pay shall be increased by an additional \$5.00 per hour.

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to finalize the acquisition of the real property in order to proceed with the amendment to the collective bargaining agreement in a timely manner. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
