## ORDINANCE NO. 271-06

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, AND THE AUDITOR OF STATE OF OHIO, 88 E. BROAD ST., P.O. BOX 1140, COLUMBUS, OHIO 43216-1140, FOR THE GAAP CONVERSION SERVICES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2006, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Agreement between the City of Jackson, Ohio, and the Auditor of State of Ohio, 88 E. Broad St., P.O. Box 1140, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1140, for the GAAP Conversion Services for the City of Jackson for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2006. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". The cost of this contract shall be in an amount not to exceed Sixteen Thousand Six Hundred Fifty No/100 Dollars (\$16,650.00), and shall be paid from line items 110-7750-53007 (Professional Services).

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the further reason that it is necessary to enter into this Agreement as soon as possible in order to coordinate and commence with the 2006 GAAP Conversion Process. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
