ORDINANCE NO. 22-07

AN ORDINANCE REVOKING AND ANNULLING ORDINANCE NO. 276-06, RELATING TO SEWER RATES, SO AS TO ELIMINATE THE SEWER RATE INCREASES SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 276-06, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2006. Ordinance No. 276-06 was passed and adopted by Jackson City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 276-06 set forth new sewer rates for customers of the City of Jackson, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council now desires to eliminate the sewer rate increases set forth in Ordinance No. 276-06, and return to the rate structure that was in existence prior to the passage of Ordinance No. 276-06.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. Ordinance No. 276-06, as adopted by Jackson City Council on December 14, 2006, is hereby revoked, and any and all sewer rate increases established by Ordinance No. 276-06 are hereby revoked and annulled, and sewer rates shall revert to the rates that were in existence and effect prior to the passage of Ordinance No. 276-06.

<u>Section Two.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to revoke the increased sewer rates as soon as possible in order to prevent customers from paying the increased rates. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
