## ORDINANCE NO. 178-07

<u>Section One.</u> Council hereby revokes and annuls Ordinance No. 133-07, and hereby authorizes the City Administration to re-bid the project for the demolition and salvage of the building known as the Buckeye Community Services Building, 166 Pearl Street, Jackson, Ohio 45640.

<u>Section Two.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to re-bid this project as soon as possible in order to commence with the demolition and salvage as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
