ORDINANCE NO. 36-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF JACKSON TO BE LEVEL 3 PARTNERS WITH THE JACKSON COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OFFICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

<u>Section One.</u> The City of Jackson is hereby authorized to be a Level 3 partner with the Jackson County Economic Development Board. As a Level 3 partner the City of Jackson is hereby authorized to pay the sum of Thirty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$ 30,000.00), to be payable as follows:

- \$15,000.00 from line item 701-7510-53007, Water Fund, Professional Service.
- \$ 15,000.00 from line item 711-7525-53007, Sewer Fund, Professional Service.

<u>Section Two.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that the City needs to become a partner as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121 22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
