## ORDINANCE NO. 114-09

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ADVANCEMENT OF FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

<u>Section One.</u> There is hereby advanced moneys from the Sewer Fund to the Sewer Plant Improvement Fund as follows:

The moneys advanced are not in any way considered to be a transfer and is in no way considered to be a transfer. The funds advanced by the Sewer Plant Fund shall be reimbursed upon receipt of the EDA Grant Funds.

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to advance these moneys as soon as possible in order to pay the contractor on the Sewer Plant Improvement Project while the City awaits the disbursement from EDA of the grant funds. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
