ORDINANCE NO. 85-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE JACKSON CITY AUDITOR TO MAKE REIMBURSEMENTS FOR THE YEAR 2009 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MAXXIMUS COST ALLOCATION STUDY, AND DECALRING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has employed Maxximus to provide cost allocations for the City to provide guidance in the reimbursement of funds to the various City departments; and

WHEREAS, Maxximus has prepared a reimbursement recommendation for the year 2009; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council now desires to accept the Maxximus recommendations and authorize the reimbursements as prescribed by Maxximus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to post these transactions as soon as possible for bookkeeping purposes. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
