ORDINANCE NO. 02-12

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING REDUCTIONS OF PREVIOUS APPROPRIATIONS IN THE: COPS FAST GRANT; COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT; PROGRAM INCOME; AND WATER STREET REPAIR FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The prior appropriations regarding the funds set forth below are hereby modified so as to reduce previous appropriations as follows:

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in that it is necessary to reduce the prior appropriations due to the fact that the estimated revenue is not anticipated to be received to cover the appropriations that were in the temporary budget for these items. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section 3.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the

deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
