ORDINANCE NO. 55-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE TO THE UNITED HEALTH CARE, THROUGH FREEDOM CHOICE BENEFITS GROUP, LLC, 78 BROADWAY STREET, JACKSON, OHIO AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio hereby finds that United Health Care, submitted the lowest responsible and responsive proposal for the contract for health insurance coverage for City employees as follows:

Employee only	\$	663.22 / month
Employee & spouse	\$	1389.46 / month
Employee & child	\$	1257.42 / month
Employee, spouse & child	\$	1983.66 / month
Employee & children	\$	1257.42 / month
Family	\$	1983.66 / month

The above policies of insurance shall be administered through Freedom Choice Benefits Group, LLC, 78 Broadway Street, Jackson, Ohio 45640. The City shall utilize the Max 105 program in paying rates, and any funds in excess of the premiums shall be utilized to offset future rate increases. Under the Max 105 plan, the rates to be paid to plan administrators shall be as follows:

Employee only	\$	730.87 / month
Family	\$	2185.99 / month


Section 2. The Mayor and/or the Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract for insurance according to the terms of the accepted proposal.

Section 3. This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in order to maintain continuous insurance coverage as required by contract with the bargaining agreements and contracts with the City employees.

Section 4. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


