ORDINANCE NO. 51-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF BELL EQUIPMENT COMPANY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$158,581.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 20 CUBIC YARD HEIL PT 1000 ON A FRIEGHTLINER CHASSIS AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for a 2014 20-yard Heil PT 1000 on a Freightliner Chassis for the City of Jackson, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid was from Bell Equipment Company, 850 Science Blvd, Gahanna, Ohio 43230, for a cost not to exceed \$158,581.00; to be taken from the following accounts: #110-7750-~~54002~~ - \$52,256.00; #228-7625-~~54002~~ - \$106,093.00; #721-7540-~~54002~~ - \$232.00; and
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WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as delivery of the equipment is within 90 to 120 days and that obtaining the truck for use at the earliest time possible and at this purchase price is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to accept the bid submitted by Bell Equipment Company for a maximum cost of \$158,581.00; to be taken from the following accounts: #110-7750-54002 - \$52,256.00; #228-7625-54002 - \$106,093.00; #721-7540-54002 - \$232.00, and to execute those documents necessary for the purchase of the truck.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in that it is necessary to approve this additional appropriation in order to pay for the purchase the truck for the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
