ORDINANCE NO. 29-17

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING REIMBURSEMENT TO RIGHT OF WAY FUND FROM THE ELECTRIC, WATER AND SEWER FUNDS FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2017 TO JUNE 7, 2017 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The prior appropriations regarding the funds set forth below are hereby modified so as to make reimbursement as follows:

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare as these funds are required to make reimbursements from the Water, Sewer and Electric Funds to the General Fund for Right of Way Reimbursements for the period beginning January 1, 2017 through June 7, 2017. This matter constitutes an emergency and is necessary to maintain the health, safety and welfare of the City so that the funds will be available to meet the obligations of the City budget as approved. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the


public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
