## ORDINANCE NO. 07-21

## AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 131.10 TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON AND CREATING THE POSITION OF POLICE CHAPLAIN.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson concurs with the determination of the Chief of the Jackson City Police Department and the Director of Public Service and Safety that the position of a Police Chaplain would be beneficial to the City and its citizen; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby establishes the position of Police Chaplain and directs that the following be added as Section 131.10 to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Jackson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT SECTION 131.10 BE ADDED AND MADE PART OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON AND THAT IT BE PLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE AT ITS NEXT PUBLICATION AS FOLLOWS:

## 131.10 POLICE CHAPLAIN.

- (A) The position of Police Chaplain shall be a voluntary position to be appointed by the Director of Public Service and Safety upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police. The Police Chaplain shall be under the supervision of the Chief of Police and shall perform the Chaplain's duties in accordance with the rules, policy and procedures as my be adopted by the Chief from time to time.
- (B) Any person appointed as Chaplain shall be an ordained clergyman and in good standing with their religious order.
- (C) The Chaplain shall serve without rank or salary. The Chaplain shall serve for a term of one year or until resignation by the Chaplain or by dismissal in accordance with R.C. section 737.12.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
